

CHINESE VISA

- Application available for the following nationalities:
U.S.A., Japan, Philippines, etc.
- The following documents are required:
 - * One application form must be written with BLACK pen, NOT blue, red...
 - * Passport --- valid for at least 4 months and more than 2 empty page. Government/Official passport is not accepted.
 - * One photo --- 3 x 4 cm (passport size), white background.
 - * Arrival stamp, re-entry visa & SOFA stamp on the passport.
 - * One clear copy of Japanese Alien Registration card or Military ID card (both sides).
 - * Birth Certificate required for children without Military ID card.
 - * U.S.A. address & Tel No.
- Visa Fee: from 01May'10
 - < For Japanese passport > no need visa staying up to 15 days
 - * With air or land arrangement
 - < For U.S.A. passport >
Single / Double Entry: taking 6 working days --- ¥25,000./person
taking 3 working days --- ¥32,000./person
 - < For Philippine passport >
Single / Double Entry: taking 6 working days --- ¥12,500./person
taking 3 working days --- ¥20,000./person
 - * Visa Only
 - < For U.S.A. passport >
Single / Double Entry: taking 6 working days --- ¥28,000./person
taking 3 working days --- ¥35,000./person
 - < For Philippine passport >
Single / Double Entry: taking 6 working days --- ¥15,500./person
taking 3 working days --- ¥23,000./person
- Chinese Visa:
Visa will be on your passport. Present your passport at Immigration counter in China.
- Note:
 - A) Visa valid for 3 months and maximum stay up to 30 days at each entry.
 - B) There are cases that the embassy will require employment certification and financial statement from the bank. This is on a case by case basis depending on the occupation of the applicant.
 - C) All fees are non-refundable after the initial application has been submitted.
 - D) Please ask one of the agents for the best way to plan your trip.
 - E) Payment required upon visa application.
